

The long hair around the dog's throat can be properly shortened but it is not recommended to be completely shaved.



Welltrained

Body Size



Small dogs gradually increase from a low level.

Dogs with high endurance need higher training levels.

Reduce the sensitivity level to fit just one dog to avoid false triggering.

Bad mood



Do not use this product when pets are upset and depressed.

Ambient noise



Reduce the sensitivity level to avoid false triggering.



### How to tighten the USB rubber plug

For the good waterproof effect of collar, please make sure that the operation steps and methods of tightening the waterproof plug are correct. When the dog is playing or swimming in the water for a long time, please remove the collar.

Complicated dynamic usage scenarios will affect the waterproof performance of the rubber stopper and may also cause false triggering.



IP67 means the unit can be dropped into a body of water up to a meter deep for half an hour, and it is dust-proof. This is the static test result in the laboratory.

### **CAUTION**



Pull the root of the rubber stopper



Keep the rubber plug parallel to the product surface. Align the 3 plug columns vertically

to the hole.



Press the rubber plug vertically. Ensure that 3 columns fill in the holes.

#### Main features test



### Test e shock feature

When the collar assembly is completed it is recommended to perform a main feature test. Please follow the procedure below to test. The e shock feature needs to be tested through the test unit.



By setting turn on the vibration function and e shock function



Blow into the sensor to trigger the product. Beep vibration and e shock wil be executed one by one.



The e shock feature needs to be tested with the test unit. If the e shock feature works normally the test light will light up.



The higher the e shock level the brighter the light.

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### Wearing steps

The dog's neck circumference ranges from 8in to 25in (20cm-60cm). Please set up the collar before wearing for the dog.





Adjust the buckle position and determine the length of the strap. Place the slider buckle and device in the position shown in the figure.





Insert the extra strap into the slider buckle. Prepare for wearing.





Wear the collar around the dog's neck in a personally comfortable way.





Adjust the position of the device to the position of the dog's front throat. Adjust the tightness of the strap to the best condition and make. Sure that the probes touch the skin.



### Frequently asked questions



#### FAQ

- Why does the collar not work when the dog barks?
- A: There may be three reasons for this problem. The first is that the trigger sensitivity. Second, the probe does not touch the skin, so try to adjust the belt tightness to ensure good skin contact. Third, the training level is not hight enough, so try to increase the training level.
- Q: Is the bark control collar safe and humane?
- A: All training methods will not cause any direct harm to the pet's body, but make them feel extremely uncomfortable. But even so, do not overuse this product on pets. Please refer to all WARNING and CAUTON contents in the manual.
- Q: Other dog barking sounds or other ambient noise can trigger the collar.
- A: It is possible, but the probability is very low. We optimized the dog barking waveform recognition technology to enhance the ability to resist false triggers. If a false tigger occurs, please adjust the sensitivity setting appropriately.
